Wisconsin Plating Works Upgrades Infrastructure

During 2011 and 2012, Wisconsin Plating Works and Racine Plating Divisions completed a number of infrastructure upgrades, one was the installation of security camera systems. These enable the 24-hour monitoring and recording of the interior and exterior of both divisions. These security cameras can be accessed onsite in executive offices and remotely via smartphones, I-Pads and laptops.

Lighting Systems and Controls for both Racine Plating and Wisconsin Plating Divisions were upgraded to high efficient T8 lighting during 2011 and 2012. This created better office and plant illumination and energy savings.

A VoIP phone upgrade was installed in 2012 at both the Racine Plating and Wisconsin Plating Divisions to improve efficiencies, customer service and general communications between the Divisions. The phone upgrade was complete with Fiber Optics LAN and Wi-Fi to support existing needs and future technology upgrades.

The new phone system permits paging from one division to the other, transferring of calls, and conference calling. Calls on hold will access announcements related to the 93-year history of Wisconsin Plating and its Core Competencies. Caller messages can be forwarded to smartphones, remote computers and laptops.
